1. **Airplane** - a vehicle designed for air travel that has wings and one or more engines.
2. **Airport** - a place where airplanes take off and land, with buildings for passengers to wait in.
3. **Apple** - a round fruit with red or green skin and a whitish inside.
4. **Baby** - a very young child.
5. **Backpack** - a bag that you carry on your back.
6. **Balloon** - a small, thin, rubber bag that you blow air into so that it becomes larger and rounder or longer, used as a child's toy or a decoration.
7. **Baseball** - a game in which two teams of nine players try to score points by hitting a ball and running to four places called bases.

49. **Veterinary** - Relating to the medical care and treatment of animals.
50. **Vocabulary** - The set of words known and used by a person, or specific to a language or field of study.
